The Setting

Success Criteria

- All tent team members must be involved in making the flag
- The flag can be any shape but must be no bigger than A4 size and must be laminated
- The flag must show a tent team name
- The flag must show things about the tent team members
- The flag must have a hole punched and a tie wrap ready to attach it to your tent at the camp.
